The purpose of this index is to make the 50+ issues of the Newsletter of the Sylvia Townsend Warner Society searchable, especially for the earlier issues which only exist as scans or paper copies. It is also to show the involvement of different individuals, the range of interests and connections and the sheer volume of Warneriana which the Society has investigated. While it might be thought that including every mention of a Society member's name, without regard to the weight of their involvement or action, makes an unwieldy index, this reflects their importance to the Society's activities at the time. In the early issues plans for a Weekend and the AGM inevitably appear several times: in the planning, and the execution, and the reports thereafter, so there will be inevitable duplication, but sometimes things slip through which are only mentioned on one of those occasions.

Places and people directly relevant to Sylvia Townsend Warner and Valentine Ackland's lives are indexed; more general and widely-visited places such as, for example, Dorchester and London are not. Mentions of Sylvia and Valentine are indexed when related to a particular event, activity or opinion, as sub-headings under their surnames.

Prefixes such as 'A', 'Mr' and 'The' are ignored in the alphabeticisation, except where they begin the title of a work. Mr Child is indexed under C, Granny Moxon and her cottage appear under M, but *Mr Fortune's Maggot* is also under M.

Where the Newsletters are not paginated the page numbering begins on the first page of readable text in the pdfs as downloadable from the STW website. In most cases this begins with the page on the inside of the front cover that lists the Society's officers and contact details, but sometimes the scan of that page is unreadable and cannot be indexed. In the list below 'FM' indicates that the front matter page is page 1.
